Capital Financing Sources: There are pages specific to HUD, HOME, HOPWA, CDBG, SHP, SECTION 811, SECTION 202, Low Income Housing Tax Credits, Federal Home Loan Bank, and more.

Operating Financing Sources: A narrative on how operating sources work is included, as well as pages specific to HUD, the Section 8 Housing Voucher Program, Shelter Plus Care (S+C), Section 8 SRO Program, Mainstream Housing Opportunities, and more.

Services Financing Sources: In addition to some highlighted financing and advocacy tools, this section provides information for federal financing sources such as HUD, HHS, DOE, DOL, Veterans Program, and more.

Finally, the site lists information on **Housing for Target Populations**. There is a Target Population by Service Needs Overview document, as well as project profiles, Key Issues in Youth Supportive Housing, our library resources on Housing Ex-Offenders and resources regarding Family Supportive Housing.
