

# Partnership for Permanent Housing – Rockville, MD Scattered-Site Housing First for Individuals and Families



## Partnership for Permanent Housing (PPH) Program

The PPH program uses master leases and tenant-based vouchers to connect homeless households with private-sector apartments throughout the county, providing subsidized housing and supportive services to more than 170 households.

Tenant Profile: Formerly homeless individuals and families

**Service Approach:** Case managers are trained to keep landlords informed while also protecting clients' confidentiality. When financial or behavioral issues arise, the PPH program covers debt, arranges payment plans and case managers work to solve behavioral problems. Community partners collaborate to assist clients with quickly removing barriers that may hinder housing stability. The PPH program utilizes funding to assist participants with emergency expenses as a result of unexpected events.

#### **Key Features and Innovations:**

- Due to guaranteed rental incomes, several corporate property managers and landlords participate in signing leases with voucher-holders or MCCH, which subleases to clients.
- Since HOME Tenant-Based Rental Assistance requires tenants to sign directly with landlords, MCCH works to build strong relationships to lessen background check barriers.
- Working with the Montgomery County Office of Landlord-tenant Affairs has provided leverage to get landlords to resolve maintenance problems and housing code issues.
- Political will has attributed to the program's success and growth.
  Inclusionary zoning laws have integrated low-income households, and aggressive legal tactics have compelled landlords to accept housing vouchers.
