

Piquette Square – Detroit, MISupportive Housing for Homeless Veterans



Piquette Square

This unique new construction project in Detroit combines 11,000 square feet of commercial and common space with 150 units of permanent supportive housing for homeless veterans. It is a unique collaboration between Southwest Housing Solutions, Southwest Counseling Solutions, John Dingell VA Medical Center and the Veterans Benefit Administration.

Service Approach: Detroit Regional Office to provide supportive services and housing opportunities, in collaboration with John Dingell VA Medical Center.

Key Features and Innovations:

- Approximately 18,000 individuals experience homelessness in Detroit each year—4,000 being veterans.
- 150 project-based vouchers administered by the Michigan State Housing Development Authority, including 25 HUD VASH projectbased vouchers.
- In addition to on-site service space, the project is located within one mile of the John Dingell VA Medical Center, which will provide greater access to inpatient and outpatient services.
- The project is situated on the site of the historic Studebaker factory, which was destroyed by a fire in 2005.
- Once completed, this will be the largest supportive housing project in the state of Michigan.

SWHS has financing commitments in place to develop an additional 241 units of housing and 40,000 square feet of retail and office space in six properties.
