A housing institute to expand housing opportunities for Transition Age Youth (TAY) in South Los Angeles.

Sponsored by the Corporation for Supportive Housing (CSH), Planting Seeds for Transformation is a specialized institute focused on expanding the array of housing solutions in South Los Angeles. The goal is to increase the capacity of South Los Angeles Transition Age Youth (TAY) housing providers to cultivate sustainable housing solutions that are tailored to meet the diverse needs of TAY (18 to 25 years old) in South Los Angeles. Planting Seeds for Transformation will involve a selection of current providers who operate Independent Living programs and/or Transitional Housing/Living programs. Institute participants will be provided the resources, knowledge, and tools that will expand their housing capacity to better serve TAY.

Eligibility Criteria

Housing provider operating Independent Living programs and/or Transitional Housing/Living programs in Service Planning Area 6 (South Los Angeles).

Commitment to participate in all components of the institute from August 25 to December 31, 2014 including Learning Community, technical assistance, and development of a housing project.

Providers must be serving TAY, ages 18-25, in their current programs.

Applications must be submitted by July 31, 2014. Application information and process is posted online at www.csh.org and www.communities-motion.com. Selected participants will be announced on August 15, 2014.
