



2017 Indiana Supportive Housing Institute FAQ & Clarifications Last Updated 9/23/16

Eligible Teams

Q. It is my understanding that a non-profit organization cannot attend the 2017 Institute if it will also be the non-profit entity on a LIHTC application in the November 2016 IHCDA round. Is this correct?

A. No, that is incorrect. The project that you take through the 2017 Institute cannot be a LIHTC project. However, applying for a separate project in this fall's LIHTC round does not preclude you as a development team/entity from participating in next year's Institute. A project that is competing in this year's LIHTC round wouldn't be eligible to go through the Institute since no LIHTC projects will be admitted into the Institute.

Q. The RFP says that "key senior management staff" must participate in the Institute sessions. Does this mean that an organization's executive director / executive staff must attend as the team member?

A. No. There is no requirement that executive staff must attend. Team members should, however, be in key roles that allow them engage in team decision making and to understand what their organization can offer to the development.

Eligible Projects

Q. I would like to open a recovery house and am wondering if can apply to get into the 2017 Institute.

A. A recovery house typically does not meet the requirements for supportive housing, and as such would be ineligible for the Institute, because a recovery house is generally a shared living model with limits on length of stay and requirements for sobriety. However, teams should review the RFP and webinar slides for more information.

Application Instructions

Q. Do all partners / team members have to be identified in the LOI that is due by September 30th?

A. No, all partners do not have to be finalized for the LOI submission. In the LOI, please list the potential partners you have identified. At a minimum, the lead organization needs to be identified. Team members must be finalized by the time of the full application submission due December 5th. It is okay if team members change from time of LOI to application.
