



MOVING ON INITIATIVE PROFILE

SAN FRANCISCO, CA

Background/Program Description

The Moving on Initiative (MOI) is an important part of the City's strategy to address homelessness.

MOI creates opportunities for stable permanent supportive housing tenants who no longer need or want on-site services, providing the option to move into private market housing with rental subsidy. This will free up units for currently homeless families and individuals who need housing combined with services.

Based on national best practices, the City and the San Francisco Housing Authority (SFHA) are collaborating to create the first pilot program.

Identification Process

Must be a tenant and leaseholder of a qualified supportive housing site administered through (HSH) Housing First building for 12 or more consecutive months at the date of application. Qualifying supportive housing sites include:

- SRO Housing First Master Lease Program
- Direct Access to Housing Program
- Local Operating Subsidy Program (LOSP)
- Shelter Plus Care Program
