Approved Federal Stimulus and Allowable Uses Applicable to Supportive Housing

| Resource | Source | Total | Allowable Uses |

| COVID - HUD | Project Based Rental Assistance | \$1,000,000,000 | Project based rental assistance to make up for 6 months of lost rent payment |
| COVID - HUD | Tenant Based Rental Assistance | \$400,000,000 | Tenant based rental assistance (\$400 million of \$1.25 billion) for public housing agencies Section 8 programs, allocations for agencies that experience an increase in voucher/unit cost |
| COVID - HUD | Section 811 & 202 | \$65,000,000 | Rental assistance for elderly and persons with disabilities. \$10 million is set aside for service coordinators and services grants for residents of 202 housing. |
| COVID - HUD | CDBG -CV | \$5,000,000,000 | Community Development Block Grant can be used for capital/acquisition/rehab, rental assistance, and services as the 15% cap on services is lifted for CV funds |
| COVID - HUD | ESG | \$4,000,000,000 | Homeless Assistance Grants, can be used for short/medium term rental assistance and services |
| COVID - HUD | HOPWA | \$65,000,000 | Can be used for capital, operating, and services |
| COVID - HHS | CSBG | \$1,000,000,000 | Community Services Block Grant can be used for services and activities to help families and individuals achieve self-sufficiency, find and retain meaningful employment, attain an adequate education, make better use of available income, obtain adequate housing, and achieve greater participation in community affairs. |

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| COVID - HHS | ACL | \$200,000,000 | Can be used for supportive services at aging and disability resource centers |
| COVID - HHS | SAMHSA | \$15,000,000 | Can be used for mental health and substance abuse treatment |
| COVID - HHS | SAMHSA | \$60,000,000 | Can be used for mental health and substance abuse treatment for individuals experiencing homelessness |
| COVID - HHS | Runaway/Homeless Youth | \$25,000,000 | Can be used to supplement, not supplant, existing funds and shall be available without regard to matching requirements |
| COVID - HHS | Title IV-B | \$45,000,000 | Can be used for child welfare prevention services |
| COVID - HHS | DV | \$45,000,000 | Can be used for family violence and prevention services |
| COVID - HHS | SAMHSA | \$100,000,000 | Emergency Response Grants can be used to provide flexible funding to address mental health, substance use disorders, and provide resources and support to youth and the homeless |
| COVID - HHS | HRSA | \$90,000,000 | Can be used for efforts to prepare for, prevent, and respond to COVID 19 - staff training, coordination for care of unsheltered individuals, enhance telemedic care, increased capacity for triaging , equipment and transportation |
| COVID-USDA | RD | \$25,000,000 | Can be used for telehealth and distance learning for underserved rural areas |
| COVID-USDA | CCC | \$100,000,000 | Can be used for broadband for rural communities (telehealth infrastructure) |
| COVID-FCC | FCC | \$200,000,000 | Can be used for broadband for rural communities (telehealth infrastructure) |
