Coordinated Entry Leadership Team Description	<p>The Chicago Coordinated Entry Leadership Team was created to offer oversight and guidance to the Coordinated Entry System (CES) by giving input and direction to shape the CES vision while finding solutions to improve the overall system. This group is facilitated by CSH and meets monthly as a team while smaller break-out groups may meet more often as needed. This team is comprised of leaders from the CoC including the CE Lead Entities and can call upon additional critical voices as needed.</p>

Coordinated Entry Temporary Prioritization Data

The CE Temporary Prioritization focused on households at high risk for COVID-19 and tested negative was implemented on 5/11/20. This plan was updated to more broadly include all households at risk of COVID-19 complications and this [CE Temporary Prioritization 2.0](#) began on 8/3/20.

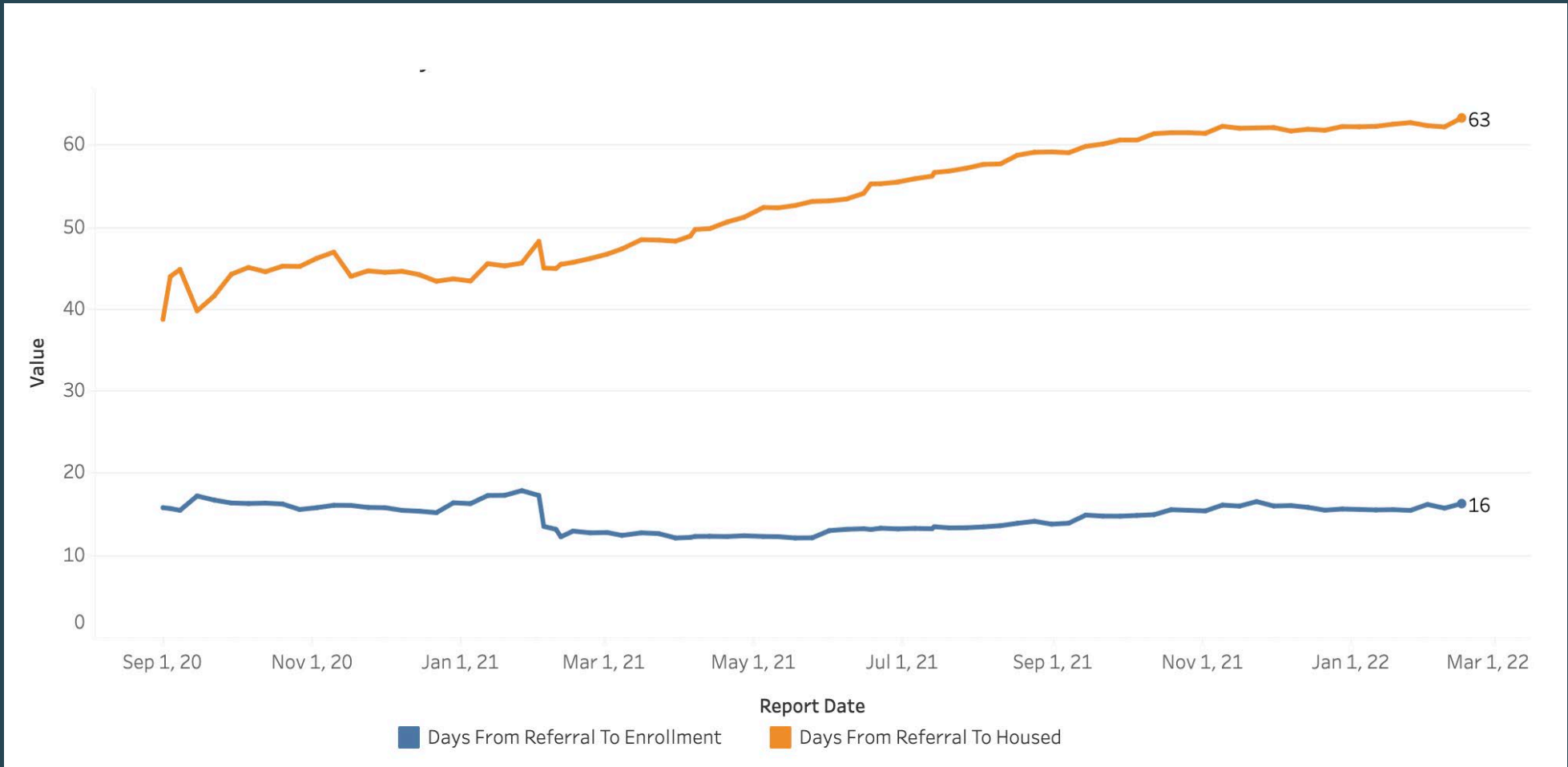
