

2025 Indiana Supportive Housing Institute Participant Attestation of Commitment

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1. All team members identified in the Cover Letter will attend each session of the 2025 Institute in full. If there are conflicts, the team will reach out to CSH in advance of the Institute start dates.
2. The team will collaborate during and between Institute sessions to develop and complete all required deliverables and submit them to CSH by the specified deadlines.
3. Team members have reviewed the 2025 RFP and agree to follow the supportive housing requirements defined on page 4-5 of the RFP.
4. The team commits to the development of a project that utilizes Coordinated Entry as the only method for tenant selection, as described in the 2025 Institute RFP, and acknowledges that adoption of additional target populations outside of those identified in the RFP will result in disqualification for continued participation in the Institute and/or loss of eligibility to apply for funds and other Institute resources.
5. The team acknowledges that significant changes to the proposed project concept or team composition will result in loss of eligibility to apply for funds and other Institute resources. 6. The team understands that projects developed through the 2025 Institute are NOT eligible to apply for LIHTC capital funds.
